As the RICS UK Licenced Assessor Trainer Jon knows what is required at the final assessment and his positive presentation style will help you to understand this important area in an interesting and accessible way. If you answer a Rules of Conduct or Professional Ethics question incorrectly at the final assessment you will be referred.
- **Final Assessment Question and Answer session** with Jon Lever FRICS and the APC assessor. Delegates are questioned on their competencies, knowledge, experience and current affairs in the same way as at the final assessment.
